QUALIFICATIONS

Candidates filing a nominating petition for board membership must meet the following qualifications:

- He/She is a citizen of the Union States of America.
- He/She must be at least 18 (eighteen) years of age.
- He/She must be able to read and write.
- He/She has been a resident of the municipality from which he/she is to be elected for at least one year preceding the date of the election.
- He/She is not disqualified as a voter pursuant to R.S. 19:4-1.
- He/She is a registered voter in the district.

No board of education member shall be directly or indirectly involved in any contract with or claim against the board.

Completed nominating petitions shall be filed with the secretary of the board on or before 4:00 p.m. of the fiftieth day preceding the date of the election, or March 1, 2010. The board office is located at Evergreen Avenue and Cedar Street, Scotch Plains, NJ 07076 and the days, dates and business hours during which the office is open to receive petitions are Monday through Friday between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m.
