MARCHING BAND UNIFORM MAINTENANCE AGREEMENT

The wearing of this uniform is a privilege and with that privilege comes the responsibility of proper care and respect.

- 1) If the uniform needs to be shortened, DO NOT CUT ANY FABRIC OFF. The pants and jacket sleeves may be hemmed by hand.
- 2) The uniforms are to be cleaned ONLY by Roberts Cleaners, Scotch Plains. There is only one location in the center of town, by CVS. They are the only cleaner who is familiar with the uniforms and if another cleaner damages the uniform you will be accountable for it. (2007 cost- \$6.00 per uniform)
- 3) Do not try to spot clean the uniforms.
- 4) Do not press seams into the uniforms that should only be done at the cleaners.
- 5) The uniforms should be taken off the wooden hanger before going to the cleaners, because they throw them away. The uniform should always be hung on the wooden hanger and in the garment bag for transporting it and hanging it, so it keeps it's shape and doesn't get wrinkled.
- 6) Black socks and black tee shirt should be worn under the uniform. White gloves are worn with the uniform, they may be hand washed and should be kept clean. (Be sure to remove the gloves from the pockets before the uniform is cleaned)
- 7) Please read the Uniform Information and Control Form and understand that you will be charged the updated cost for any lost or damaged uniform parts.
