New this year, we will also be collecting perishable items that will be given to a local food pantry that will be preparing Thanksgiving baskets. (*Requests have been made for frozen turkeys, bags of carrots, celery, potatoes, onions, apples, and cranberry or apple juice*). **We will be collecting these items at the Craft Fair on Saturday, November 17th, only.** There will be a table outside of School One that day from 10:00 a.m. – 1:00 p.m.
