

SPECIAL EDUCATION:

Special class programs are available to District students who require special education instruction for more than one half of the instructional day. These programs provide an environment where the nature of the student's impairment is the primary focus. Special-class programs provide a full continuum of alternative placements to meet the needs of students with disabilities for special education and related services. There are four self-contained special education classes at School One. The instructional program for special-needs students is in accordance with the educational program developed by the Child Study Team, special education teacher, and in consultation with the parent/guardians. Students are integrated into the mainstream program for academic subjects, specials and/or activities, whenever appropriate, as specified in their IEP (Individualized Education Program).
