

BOARD – SUPERINTENDENT RELATIONS

Date of Adoption: July 17, 1975

The Scotch Plains-Fanwood Board of Education believes that its primary function is to develop policies under which the Superintendent and staff of the school system shall operate.

The Superintendent, as chief administrative officer of the school system, shall be free to manage the various phases of the complete school program without interference, providing all policies are administered properly and efficiently.

Further, it is the duty of the Superintendent to enforce complete adherence to the Board's policies by all employees of the system and to keep the Board fully informed about all school operations. The Superintendent's effectiveness in the above areas shall be consideration by the Board in his evaluation.

The Superintendent is entitled to attend all meetings of the Board and its Committees.
