

COUNCILS, CABINETS AND COMMITTEES

Date of Adoption: October 17, 1974

The Board authorizes the Superintendent to establish permanent and temporary councils, cabinets, and committees which he deems necessary for proper administration of Board policies and for the improvement of the total educational program. All cabinets, councils and committees created by the Superintendent shall be for the purpose of obtaining to a maximum degree the professional advice and counsel of the personnel of the district.

The number, composition and work to be done by such cabinets, councils, and committees shall be defined by the Superintendent or his designated representative and shall be changed at his discretion.
