On the first day of school, we will review your class schedule and locate your hallway locker. You will also have time to get acquainted with your classmates and meet your 6th grade teachers. Please remember that we are here to help you through your first day and all the days that follow.

There are certain supplies that will help you stay organized and learn all that you can throughout sixth grade. We suggest the following supplies to start off the school year:

- 1) A three-ring, loose-leaf binder that snaps or zips closed with a sufficient supply of ruled filler paper. Please do not purchase a “trapper keeper.” This binder will be used for English, Math, Reading, Science, Social Studies and your exploratory classes.
- 2) The binder should be divided with one folder for each subject.
- 3) Please put your pencil pouch in your binder filled with pens, pencils, highlighters, eraser, colored pencils and glue sticks.
- 4) You will need two combination locks: one for your hallway locker and one for your gym locker. **Key locks are discouraged since keys are easy to lose.**

Please purchase only these necessities to get you started. Each teacher will notify you of any other supplies that are needed for special projects or activities as they come up throughout the school year.
