# Dates

- **May 17th** - First day of five day per week instruction
  - If your student would like to return to in person instruction moving forward, please notify the office a week in advance.
  - Options are attending 5 days full days or remaining all virtual.
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# Why are we moving to 5 full days?

- The time is right! Every day, the news is finally getting better locally
  - Students benefit from the experience of a more typical day before the end of the current school year.
  - Students have more time in school for continued learning acceleration and increased social skills development.
  - Teachers and administrators have the opportunity to address the challenges of operating a regular school day with COVID mitigation strategies in place, and as a result, to be better prepared for a full opening for the fall semester.
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# What do the classrooms look like?

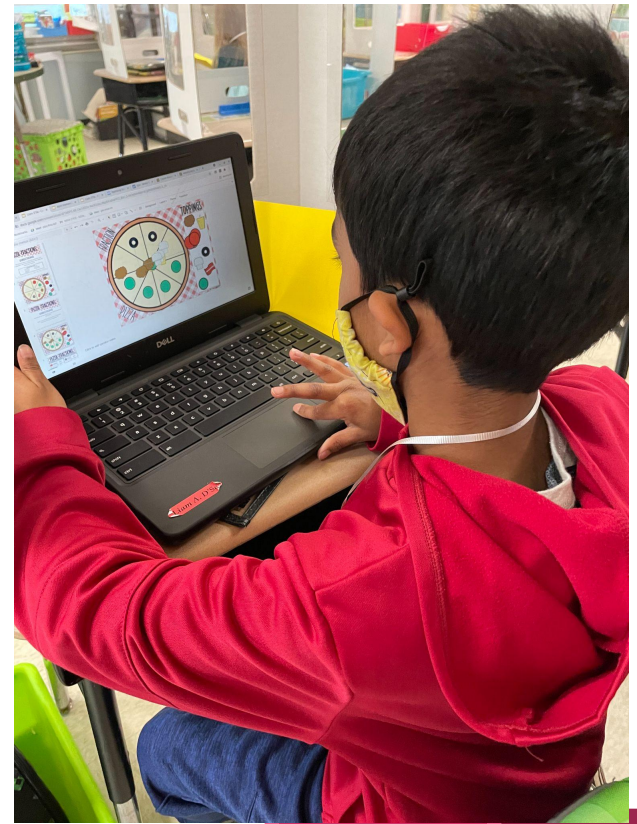
- Students will sit 3-6' apart

Class size varies from 13-21

- Desk Shields have been installed on all desks/tables. These are no longer required, but we are maintaining them for this year.
- Mask-wearing at all times
- Hand sanitizing when entering and exiting classroom

# Snack

- Two snack/mask breaks will be scheduled each day - one in the morning and one in the afternoon.
  - Snack will be outside, weather permitting
  - Snack can be in the classroom when students are seated 6' apart.
  - If students are not 6' apart, snack will be allowed on a rotating basis to limit the number of students with masks off.
  - Please provide easy to eat, allergy-free snacks. Students should be independent when opening/eating snack.
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# Lunch

- Please pack easy-to-eat, nut free lunches
  - Students will eat in the classroom or outside, depending on weather
  - Students will use sanitizer/wash hands before and after lunch
  - If students are not spaced 6' apart, the class will eat in two shifts
  - Students will remain seated at their desks
  - Students will be asked to refrain from talking while eating
  - Lunch can be outside, weather permitting - students should bring a towel or cushion to sit on
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# Recess

- Each class will have a designated space for recess within their grade level's recess area
- Designated spaces will rotate each day to provide students with different locations for recess
- Classes will not interact with one another
- Each class will have their own bag of playground equipment
- Students will use sanitizer before and after recess



# Arrival, Dismissal, and Traveling in Hallways

- Continue with assigned doors for arrival and dismissal
  - Drop Off line is available for fourth grade students - students must be able to exit car independently, volunteers can not assist
  - Dismissal will continue to be from different doors for each grade level - students are not allowed to walk in the hall to meet a sibling
  - Classes will travel to specials - all protocols (masks, desk shields, maximum distance possible, hand sanitizing when entering and leaving a room) will be in place.

# When there is a Positive Case

- Contact Tracing under direction of the Board of Health
