6th Grade Supply List 2024 – 2025

Welcome to 6th grade! We are very excited to meet you this fall. Below you will find a list of materials that will help with your transition to middle school.

- One accordion folder to organize assignments. There should be eight sections or more in the accordion folder. Please have each section of the folder labeled with each subject so that your child can stay organized from the beginning of the school year.
- 2. Three plastic-pocket folders:
 - Science
 - Writing Workshop
 - Language Arts- for Mrs. Cammarano's Class Only
- 3. Four composition books:
 - Writing Workshop
 - Math
 - Science
 - Language Arts
- 4. One pencil pouch filled with pens, pencils, highlighters, colored pencils, several packs of 3x3 Post-Its or bigger, scissors, a small roll of scotch tape, a glue stick, and an eraser. Please provide extra supplies of scotch tape and glue sticks for your child's locker, as they will need to replenish these supplies throughout the school year.
- 5. One 4-pack of low-odor dry-erase markers.
- 6. Headphones
- 7. You will need two combination locks: one for your hallway locker and one for your gym locker. Key locks are discouraged since keys are easy to lose. Helpful hint: Please have your child practice opening and closing their lock prior to the start of school.

- 5 subject dividers
- Pencils

World Language:

Ipad fully charged eveyday (Important)

- Ipad charger
- Earbuds with microphone for listening and recording activities
- 2-inch binder with white lined paper for World Language only (**no accordian folders please**)
- 3 section dividers
- 1 folder for World Language class only
- A pouch with zipper for supplies
- Pens and pencils
- A highlighter (any color)
- 2 low odor dry erase markers
- A set of coloring supplies (crayons, colored pencils and markers)
- A set of white or colored index cards

Physical Education:

For all incoming 6th, 7th and 8th graders changing for Physical Education is optional. The school provides lockers however, the student must have a combination lock to secure all valuables during class if changing. Students may wear shorts, t-shirts, sweatpants, or sweatshirts and sneakers. If a student is not changing, sneakers are still required. Sneakers are the only proper footwear for Physical Education. Students are also recommended to bring in some form of antiperspirant or deodorant (sprays are not allowed).

Each teacher will notify you of any other supplies that are needed for special projects or activities as they come up throughout the school year.
