

Dear Second Grade Student,

Below is a list of suggested school supplies that will be helpful for you to keep in class next year. They will help you to work well and stay organized.

- Small Headphones for the computer -(**NOT earbuds or earplugs**)
LABELED WITH YOUR CHILD'S NAME
- 2 plastic pocket folders (**horizontal pockets only**)
- 5 JUMBO glue sticks (unlabeled to be placed into a class sharing container)
- 1 box of **thin** magic markers (Crayola is best)
- 2 boxes of Crayola crayons (no more than 32) we are saving the extra box to replenish the students' crayons in the end of January
- 2 boxes of Crayola colored pencils (no more than 12) we are saving the extra box to replenish the students' pencils in the end of January
- a plastic pencil box
- 1 pair of child safe scissors to keep in pencil box
- 3 marble composition books (2 Word Study and Spanish)
- 1 pack of white unlined 3in. x 5in. index cards
- 3 post-it pads (about 2 in. x 3 in. size) unlabeled to be placed into a class sharing container
- 3 dozen pencils (unlabeled to be placed into a class sharing container-preferably **TICONDEROGA brand** and sharpened if at all possible)
- block erasers
- 2 **yellow only please** highlighters
- 3 **black only please** dry-erase markers
- recent photo of yourself for our class book
- a favorite book
- small pack of tissues to keep in your desk
- one inch loose leaf binder
- Boys-box of gallon size Ziploc Slide freezer bags (**they are stronger**)
- Girls-box of quart size Ziploc Slide freezer bags (**they are stronger**)
- 2 boxes of tissues for classroom supply
- Smock for Art and other projects - **an old tee-shirt is perfect**

DAILY: A small healthy snack and juice box or water bottle (please bring daily packed separately from lunch)

It would also be helpful for you to keep the following items at home: pencils, a gluestick, a calculator, old magazines and a 12-inch ruler.
