
# CLUBS PROCESS FOR PROPOSALS

### 1. PRE-SEARCH

Review the list of existing clubs and clarify how yours avoids repeating or significantly overlapping with other clubs' missions/visions.



## 2. MEET

Meet with advisor(s) of those clubs that might be doing similar work and/or have shared missions/visions.



# 3. CONSIDER

Remember it is fine - and encouraged! to bring/start a **new initiative** within an existing club - you will already have support!



### 4. MEET

Meet with Ms. Lockwood to review your pre-search and advisor meeting(s)



### 4. CLARIFY INTEREST

Clarify interest by collecting 25 signatures of students who would likely attend your meetings and be part of your club If you would like to have an interest meeting, contact Ms. Lockwood



### 5. SUBMIT PROPOSAL

Complete a proposal for a new club



### 6. COMMITTEE REVIEW

The Student Activities Committee, composed of teachers and administrators, review proposals once a month

Student Council/Class Officers & SGA are groups of student leaders who will help you execute initiatives and events - you do not *have* to start a new club to bring new ideas and events to our school community!
