1	Composition Book Primary Journal – 9.75 in. x 7.5 in. Story Book Black Marble (if possible)
4	Elmer's Glue Sticks (preferably disappearing purple)
1	Crayola Watercolor Set with Brush (8 colors in all)

1	24 count box of Crayola Crayons

Please try to label the items

5	Dry erase markers (black) /sock for erasing
1	A small pencil sharpener (with a holder to collect shavings)
1	scissor
3	Glue sticks

12	Sharpened pencils(will need to add more during the year)
1	Chapter book for independent reading(have for the first day)
2	Pocket folders - 1 for Homework and 1 for Classwork
1	Pencil case (to hold pencils/sharpener/ dry erase marker/highlighter/sock/glue stick) The extra supplies will be able to store in their bins

4th Grade Supply List

- 4 composition books (Mead composition notebooks, for example)
- 1 green folder, plastic (if possible)
- 1 blue folder, plastic (if possible)
- 1 red folder, plastic (if possible)
- 1 additional folder of your choice
- 3 pads of 3x3 post its (will have to be replenished throughout the year)
- 1 dozen pencils (sharpened) (will have to be replenished throughout the year)
- 1 12 pack of colored pencils
- 2 Expo markers
- 1 eraser (no pencil topper erasers please, as these are easily lost)
- 1 **small**, zip, soft pencil case (no hard plastic boxes please)
- 1 yellow highlighter
- 1 manual, handheld quiet pencil sharpener (not battery operated)
- 2 black felt tip pens, medium point (PaperMate Flair Pen, black, for example)
- 1 pair of earbuds or small headphones (**must** be able to fit in personal pencil case)
