## \*\* IMPORTANT INFORMATION\*\*

As we move forward, if students are not sick and there were no extenuating circumstances, please be reminded that in the district's communication to parents on March 4th it was shared that students who choose the in-person option are expected to be in school every day. Further, it was noted:

> Students would be permitted to log in and attend class remotely without being marked absent if the student was quarantined or isolated due to Covid-19 or the student is generally feeling well but was ordered by their health care provider to recuperate at home after a contagious illness or medical/ surgical procedure.

Any other request for virtual learning would require approval from the principal or nurse.

In the future, if you are having the children log in virtually, please notify the school if it is due to medical reasons or check-in with either me or the nurse for approval. Otherwise, children will be marked absent if they are virtually attending without prior notice.

PUPIL ASSIGNMENT PROCESS: As we begin to plan for the 2021/2022 school year, please keep in mind that students are placed in heterogeneous class sections. Many factors are thoroughly examined and discussed. These include both the students' academic performance in all components of the curriculum, and their social interactions in relationship to peers. We strive to maintain a balance in the classroom. Groupings are developed according to students' study habits and levels of participation during class instruction.

We realize that parents have valuable information to share regarding their children's specific needs. Should there be any special factors you feel are necessary for us to consider, you may express them in writing to the principal's office. Your input will be taken under advisement. We respectfully request that you do NOT request a specific teacher by name. Your support and encouragement regarding your children's assignment will be important in ensuring they have a successful year.

NEW REGISTRANTS: Parents of children in Grades 1 through 4 who will be enrolling at School One in September and were enrolled in private or parochial schools this year are urged to contact the Main Office at this time. This is particularly important for children entering our first-grade program. Children registering for first grade must be at least 6 years of age on or before October 1, 2021.
