

PRINCIPAL'S MESSAGE: I would like to express my gratitude to our excellent staff for preparing for our students to return to our Hybrid Model. Also, our pre-k and kindergarten students will remain receiving report cards twice a year and will be distributed on Wednesday, February 17th and Thursday, June 24rd.

Additionally, schools will follow a single session on Wednesday, November 25 and are not required to log-in for the 2:00-3:00 p.m. afternoon session.
