PARENT/TEACHER CONFERENCE WEEK: Parent-teacher conferences will be held on Wednesday, November 2<sup>nd</sup>, Thursday, November 3<sup>rd</sup>, and Friday, November 4<sup>th</sup>. Evening conferences are scheduled for Thursday, November 3<sup>rd</sup>. There is an overflow day scheduled for Monday, November 7<sup>th</sup>. Students will follow a single-session schedule, please refer to the arrival and dismissal times below. <u>STUDENT DISMISSAL</u>: The office has been experiencing student dismissal calls very late in the afternoon (after 3:00 p.m.). Many times, it can be difficult for the office to reach a teacher especially if the class is returning from a special, outside at the end of day, or in between dismissal. While we understand extenuating circumstances, please make sure to contact the office well in advance if there is a change in your child's dismissal. This will provide the office plenty of time to make the teacher aware of the change so that the teacher can safely dismiss your child.

**BUS SAFETY:** Please make sure that you follow all proper traffic laws with regards to our school buses. We kindly ask that when you are driving and you see a bus with a stop sign out, **please stop and wait patiently**. The safety of our children should be our number one priority and we all need to chip in to do our part.

**LUNCH PROGRAM (GRADES K - 4):** School lunches are \$3.50 and on pizzeria pizza day, an EXTRA slice is \$2.75. A copy of the November menu can be found on the district website. Gluten-free menus are available by request only. Please contact the Main Office if you would like to receive a copy.

For easy service, students should have balances on their PaySchool accounts to purchase lunch from the food service lines. To register for an account, please visit <a href="www.payschoolscentral.com">www.payschoolscentral.com</a>. Cash and checks (payable to the Scotch Plains BOE) are accepted. Please be sure to provide an envelope marked with your child's name and "Lunch Money" clearly printed.

Please keep in mind that the school is unable to provide refrigeration for lunches brought from home or heat lunches that students bring to school.
