WHAT IS QSACP

- PLAINS-PANTAGO DE LO SCHOOLS
- NJQSAC is the Department of Education's monitoring and evaluation system for public school districts.
- It is a single comprehensive accountability system that consolidates and incorporates the monitoring requirements of applicable state laws and programs and complements federally required improvements.
- The system focuses on monitoring and evaluating school districts in five key components which, based on research, have been identified to be key factors in effective school districts.

WHAT IS QSACP

PLAINS-RANGE OF SCHOOLS

Once every three years, districts are required to undergo a full NJQSAC evaluation and must complete the District Performance Review (DPR).

The QSAC Process

- > Become familiar with DPRs
- > Establish an internal team
- Identify a person to oversee each of the 5 areas
- Have that person validate documentation and where it can be located
- The entire QSAC team has to agree with documents to be submitted
