

Annual Notification Letter: 2025 / 2026

To Parents/Guardians, Teachers, Students, & Employee Organizations:

In accordance with the Asbestos Hazard Emergency Response Act (AHERA) parents, guardians, teachers, children, and employees of the Scotch Plains – Fanwood School District must be notified annually of the district’s activities regarding asbestos found in the schools.

Under the AHERA Regulation it was required that all educational facilities be inspected for asbestos containing materials. Subsequent Tri-Annual Re-inspections and periodic surveillances (every six months) are required to update and maintain the Asbestos Management plan. The last 3-Year Re-Inspection was conducted in November 2022.

AHERA Consultants, Inc. will be conducting the next periodic surveillance in May 2025; surveillances were conducted in both May & November 2024. The next 3-Year Re-Inspection will be performed in November 2025. Following the surveillance & 3-Year Re-Inspection(s), all reports will be assimilated into the Management Plan and be available inside the main office of the Administration Building. They will be available for review during normal operating hours.

During this past year, Operations & Maintenance projects were additionally performed at various buildings.

AHERA Consultants, Inc. can schedule to conduct an awareness-training seminar for all custodial and maintenance staff. The District’s Facilities Director, Nicholas Crupi, will keep us informed of any potential asbestos issues within the district.
