Your frequently asked questions...

How can I prepare for the PSAT 10?

Get a good night's sleep the night before and eat a protein filled breakfast.

What materials should I bring with me on test day?

- Completed COVID Symptom Screening form. If you cannot print the form, they will be available in your testing room.
- mask
- #2 pencils,
- calculator. **We will not be supplying calculators.**

What time should I get to school?

7:45 am

What testing room am I assigned to?

You will be emailed your testing room assignment the week of March 8. It is a good idea to take a picture of this information. Room assignment information will be posted in school also.

What will the check-in procedure look like?

Enter door 1 or 12. Report directly to your assigned testing room. A faculty member will confirm completion of your **COVID screening form**. Forms will also be available in the testing rooms also.

How many students will be in my testing room?

A maximum of 10 students will be assigned to testing rooms.

Can I bring food or a drink?

No food or drink is allowed in the testing room.

Will I need to wear my mask at all times?

Yes, and your mask must cover your mouth and nose.

I'm worried about missing my classes that day. What should I do?

Don't worry! No sophomore classes will be running on Thursday, March 11. Your "B day" teachers will give you assignments that will be due at your next class meeting. (Monday, March 15)

When will I be dismissed from SPFHS?

You are permitted to leave after the test is concluded.

I take the bus. When will the bus pick me up?

The bus will come at 1:10 pm to pick you up. When the test is over, you will wait in the cafeteria.
