On Thursday, March 11, 2021 the PSAT 10 test will be administered to all sophomores at Scotch Plains-Fanwood High School. In order to meet CDC guidelines for social distancing, students will be assigned to test rooms with no more than ten students. As a result, all faculty will be utilized to administer testing throughout the building.

In order to meet this physical space requirement, March 11th will be an asynchronous school day for students in grades 9, 11, and 12. March 11th will be a fully remote learning (Block B classes) day for students in grades 9, 11, and 12. Teachers will assign lessons and activities in their Google Classrooms for students to complete independently and submit by 3:00 pm. The submitted work will verify their presence in class and will be documented in PowerSchool for attendance purposes. <u>Members of the sophomore class should report directly to their testing room at the high school on March 11th. Room assignment information will be issued under separate cover. Students in self-contained classes will receive additional instruction details from the Department of Special Services.</u>

Administering the PSAT under the proper conditions provides our sophomore class with an important academic experience. The PSAT provides the students with the opportunity to practice for the SAT (The College Board), enter The National Merit Scholarship Corporation, and the New Jersey Department of Education recognizes the PSAT as one of several assessments used to meet graduation requirements.
