PowerSchool Parent Portal Daily Symptom Screening Instructions

Completing Daily Symptom Screening Forms - complete only on the days your child will be attending school in person.

1. Login to your SPF PowerSchool Parent Portal account at <https://ps.spfk12.org/public> on your computer or mobile device. If you are accessing your account on your phone, you must use the web browser on your phone, not the PowerSchool App. If you have more than one child, you must complete the form for each child.

Note: The School Bulletin in the PowerSchool App also has links to the PS Parent Portal website. Click on the cog in the app to show the Daily Bulletin and then click on the Bulletin to see the links.

Daily Symptom Screening

1. Has the student had any one (1) or more of the following symptoms in the past 24 hours? *

If so, they are to stay home and log onto remote learning. If the student is too ill to participate, call the school's attendance line to report the absence. Contact the school nurse as well as your medical provider for further instructions. Medical clearance will be needed to return to school.

2. Has the student had two (2) or more of the following symptoms in the past 24 hours? *

3. Please verify the following statements. *

If any one of the statements, regarding illness, close contact, or possible exposure is checked, remain at home, login to virtual learning, and report the absence. Contact the school nurse as well as your medical provider for further instructions. Medical clearance will be needed to return to school.

The student has tested positive for COVID and NOT completed 10 days of isolation.

The student has been in close contact with a person who has tested positive for COVID within the past 14 days. Close contact is defined as being within 6 feet of an infectious person for 15 minutes over a 24 hour period. The 15 minutes can be continuous or cumulative.

Someone in your household is diagnosed with COVID-19.

Student has traveled to an area of high community transmission in the past 14 days that requires quarantine upon return.
