## Student parking is a privilege!

## Please Read All Driving and Parking Regulations

Student parking is permitted in the parking lot that extends from the main side entrance to the soccer field and in those spaces located off school property that are provided by the office and/or police department. The regulations listed below are issued to promote safety and order in the driveways and parking lots around the High School. It should be clearly understood that failure to comply with the regulations and conditions will mandate revocation of the driving privilege.

1. Students who want to park in a designated school assigned location, must register their motor vehicle properly by completing this form and providing a copy of each vehicle's registration.

2. UNAUTHORIZED PARKING: Any car parking in the designated areas must display their official parking permit on the rear view mirror. These permits will be issued only upon completion and approval of this registration form. Cars not displaying the appropriate permit will be ticketed. *Parking permits are NON-TRANSFERABLE. Students may not sell or give their permit to another individual. Failure to comply will result in Saturday Detention and loss of parking privileges.* Students who have off-campus parking spots who park on campus will receive a Saturday Detention, upon second instance, the student will lose their parking permit for any school designated parking. Cars must be parked in spaces clearly marked for parking. "No Parking" areas must be avoided at all times. *Cars parked illegally will be ticketed*.

3. **SAFETY**: Students must drive on school property with extreme caution and consideration. The maximum speed limit in all driveways and parking lots is **15** m.p.h. Any evidence of reckless or careless driving will result in the removal of driving privileges. Students must avoid any unnecessary noise while driving on school property, including loud music playing.

4. **ATTENDANCE:** Students who exceed 15 absences from school will have their parking permit revoked for the remainder of the school year. Failure to surrender the parking permit will result in suspension from school. Students who exceed tardy allotment will also lose parking permit privileges.

5. Students may not go to their cars between 8:08 a.m. and 2:24 p.m. unless they are leaving the school property with an approved early dismissal, or unless they have authorized permission from administration. Students who are unauthorized to leave school property during the school day will **immediately** lose parking privileges.

6. Should it be necessary to revoke a driving privilege and the student involved is found driving on school property, it will be considered a *very serious violation*. Students who lose privileges are required to surrender their parking tag within 24 hours.

7. If you no longer plan to drive to school and do not need your parking spot you must surrender your parking tag to the attendance office. Any spots left empty for 3 weeks time will lose parking privileges.

I have read the regulations above and understand that it is my responsibility to comply with them at all times. I understand that failure to comply with these regulations will result in the revocation of my school driving permit.
