

  - We had two nights of energizing performances and made \$10,462.90, approximately \$2,000 over our budgeted amount.

## **Overall Fundraising**

- Our budget for this year was crafted using the 2021-2022 budget of \$17,960 and the pre-pandemic budget from 2019-2020 of \$37,500.
- We were cautiously optimistic and budgeted \$30,700, but we are currently projected to finish the year at \$46,411.
- We will need to find places to use an extra \$10,000 and then will look to roll over 0 approximately 50% more than last year, for a total of \$16,000.

Susan proposes that we roll over extra money for next year as long as we designate what it is going to be used for. Rosalina said she checked in the fall and will check again to make sure this is allowed.
