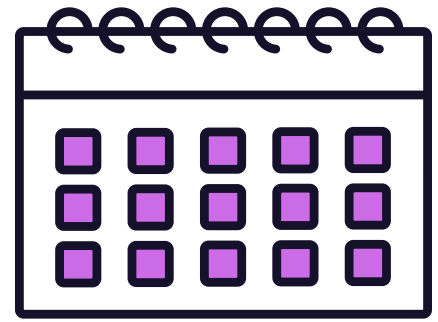

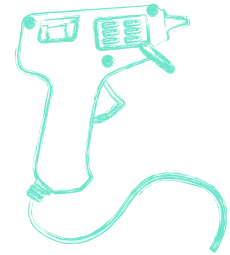

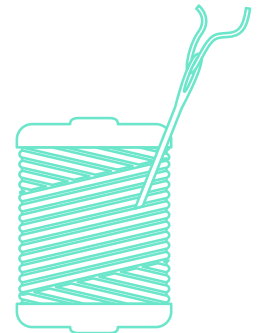


FIX YOUR OWN CLOTHES, MAKE MONEY, AND SAVE THE PLANET

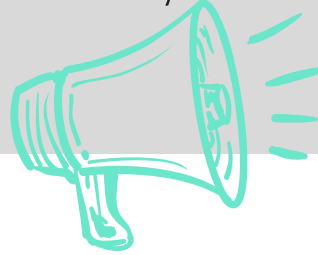

Snacks will be provided. No registration required.

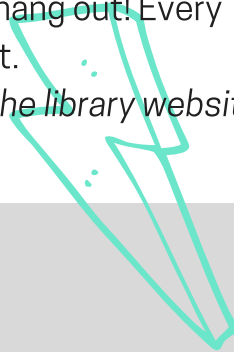


MIDDLE SCHOOL SCENE

No registration required. Please check the library website in case of cancellations.

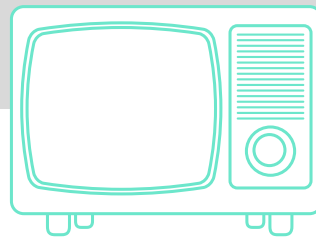


ANIME CLUB

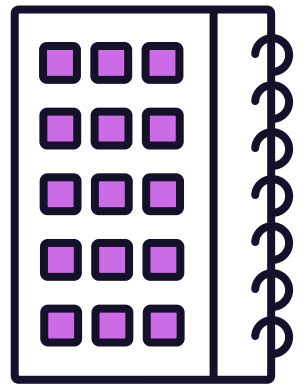
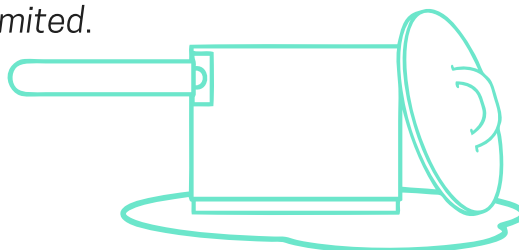


POP-UP KITCHEN
