This is a group through which parents can discuss issues and concerns impacting their children and support the district in improving the services to and outcomes of all children participating in special education and/or related services.

Our meeting schedule is posted on the district web site under the "Departments" tab then "Special Services" tab as well as being listed on the district calendar and announced via PTA e-mail blasts (please look for "SEPAG Meeting" in those blasts!)
