Haven't been able to teach your child how to ride a two-wheel bicycle yet? Then come to the **Training Wheel Toss** and let the Fanwood Recreation Commission have a try!

Here's what you need to know:

- Each cyclist must wear a <u>helmet</u> and have a bicycle <u>with pedals</u> and that is in <u>good working condition</u>.
- Each cyclist must be able to rest his or her <u>feet flat on the</u> <u>ground while sitting</u> on his or her bicycle seat.
- All cyclists must be <u>at least four</u> <u>years old</u> and be accompanied by an adult throughout the session. No exceptions.

Failure to meet <u>any</u> of the above conditions will DISQUALIFY your child from participating in this event.



- We ask parents or guardians to **remove training wheels** prior to the event, if possible.
- On the day of the event, you will be required to sign a **liability waiver** to participate in the program.

The Training Wheel Toss is **FREE** for Fanwood and Scotch Plains* residents, but you <u>must register</u> in advance by going to **fanwoodrecreation.org** in order to participate. Space is limited!
