An elementary 4th-grade chorus is part of the overall elementary program. It is a separate and mandatory program for all fourth graders. Chorus meets for one class period once a week. The chorus performs a winter and spring concert and may have other opportunities for public performance. The chorus may sing varied types of songs such as but not limited to – school, patriotic, popular, show, folk, multicultural, songs in other languages, etc. Opportunities are provided for fourth graders to showcase other talents including dancing, solo, or small group singing, accompanying, creating movement, etc., when possible.
