Course Name: Grade 7 Chorus

Course #: M6732

Course Description:

The seventh grade chorus is an elective course all seventh grade students. The course is scheduled for two 42-minute periods per 6-day cycle. Students electing to participate in band and chorus will meet for chorus for one 42-minute period per 6-day cycle. An audition is not required and attendance at all performances and rehearsals is mandatory. The chorus will sing a varied repertoire of musical literature including, but not limited to, patriotic, Broadway, folk, popular, spirituals, classical, and holiday music.

Course Proficiencies:
