Food & Drink: We suggest that children bring a snack and water if registered for the morning session, and a lunch that requires no refrigeration if registered for the afternoon session.

Supervision: For grades K–1 and 2–3 groups, campers to counselor ratio is approximately 6 or 7 to 1. For the grades 4–6 group, campers to counselor ratio is approximately 8 to 1.

Disciplinary Policy: The Fanwood Recreation Summer Park Program has a zero-tolerance policy toward bullying and aggressive behavior. This includes name-calling and exhibiting lack of respect to counselors and other campers. The parent/guardian of any camper who exhibits any of these behaviors or engages in behavior that is a danger to him/herself or to others will be called and asked to immediately remove their child from the program. Such action will result in the camper's permanent dismissal from the program. (A full refund will be issued for any unused days should this happen.)

A Word of Advice: If your child is unwilling to follow health safety guidelines, has difficulty getting along with others, doesn't enjoy group activities, gets bored easily or has no interest in attending this program, **please** do not register him or her as such children will probably not enjoy this program and often become a disruption to the other campers.

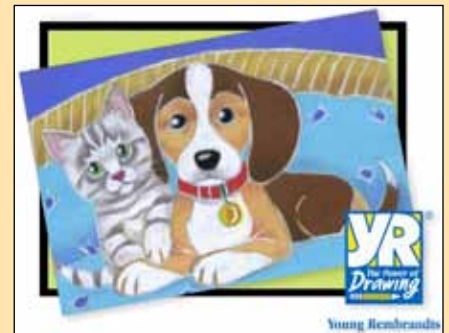
