The Scotch Plains - Fanwood Baseball League (SPFBL) is a private, non-profit organization, comprised of volunteers, providing baseball opportunities to the youth of SPF ages Pre-K thru High School.

Recreational Baseball League Structure

- SPFBL structures its Spring Recreational Baseball League by Grade level.
- Players are not allowed to play up in grade to another division.
- Team jerseys and team hats are provided for each player.
- Each division will have a weekly team practice, length of same will vary depending on the players ages and the volunteer coach's available schedule.
- Our Spring Recreational program is open to boys and girls in the SPF community.

Division Descriptions

SENIOR LEAGUE DIVISION: (7th thru 10th grade) - Cost \$180

- Recreational competitive division
- Games are one weeknight game and a Saturday game + Playoffs
- Carded umpires are used for these games.
- 60/90 field

MAJOR LEAGUE DIVISION (5th & 6th Grade) - Cost \$185

- Recreational competitive division- Leading & Stealing
- Games are one weeknight game and a Saturday game + Playoffs
- Carded umpires are used for these games.
- 50/70 Fields

AAA DIVISION (3rd & 4th Grade) - Cost \$185 + \$50 Work Bond

- Recreational competitive division
- Strong focus on teaching and reinforcing baseball rules and skills
- Teen Umpires are used
- 46/60 fields.
- Games one weeknight game and a Saturday game.
- Playoffs after the regular season.

MINOR LEAGUE DIVISION (2nd Grade) - Cost \$165

- Games typically play on Saturday afternoons.
- Player & Coach pitch in the games.
- Focus on development and baseball rules/skills enforced.
- Real baseballs are used.

COLLEGIATE DIVISION (1st Grade) - Cost \$165

- Developmental non-competitive division for boys and girls
- Coach Pitch at games, introduce players to kid pitch at practice.
- Games are typically played on Saturday afternoons.
- Coaches concentrate on teaching basic baseball rules and skills
- Softer baseball is used for safety

ROOKIE DIVISION (Kindergarten) - Cost \$160

- Instructional, non-competitive division for boys and girls
- Batting tee or coach pitch (maximum of 5 pitches per kid).
- Rookies typically play on Saturday afternoons.
- Coaches concentrate on teaching basic baseball rules and skills
- Softer baseball is used for safety.

SANDLOT Tee Ball DIVISION (PREK-4) - Cost \$160

- Instructional, non-competitive Tee-Ball division for boys and girls.
- Coaches teach basic baseball rules and skills.
- Games typically played on Saturday afternoons.
- A soft baseball is used for safety.
